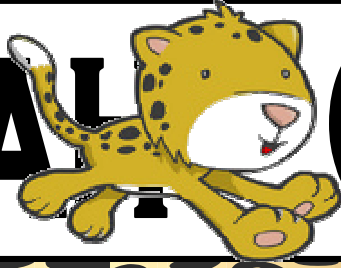

While we do welcome your input regarding your child's individual learning needs, we cannot accept emails, phone calls, nor can we hold personal conferences regarding student placement. We will certainly give parents the opportunity to provide input by writing a letter, however, placement letters should be the exception rather than the rule.

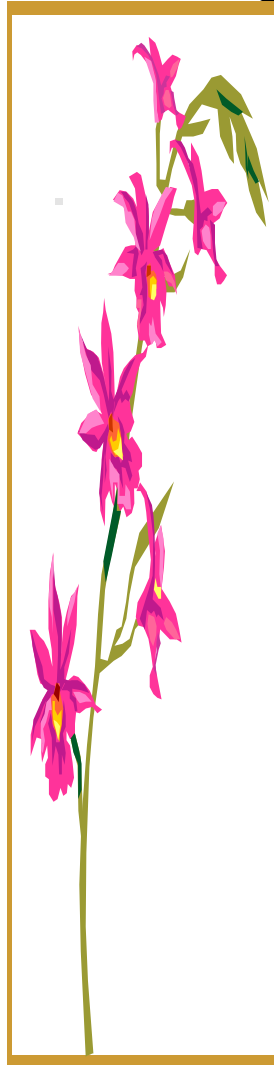
## Warm Weather Dress Code Reminder

Spring has sprung and the warm weather is officially here. Time to break out the cute shorts and spring shirts and dresses. With this in mind, we ask that you and your children review the Creek View Elementary and Fulton County Dress Code. As you pull your children's warm weather clothing out, please be mindful that the clothing items that you purchased at the beginning of the school year may be a bit shorter or snugger-fitting at this time of the year.



Students are not permitted to wear short-shorts or mini-skirts. Shorts and/or skirts should be worn at the child's middle fingertip length. Athletic shorts (Soffee's) are not allowed. T-shirts and blouses should cover the child's midriff. Spaghetti strap tank tops and dresses are not permitted. Tops must be at least three adult fingers wide at the shoulder. If school personnel determine that a student is in violation, the student will be sent to the office to have an administrator call a parent to bring in a change of clothing. We ask for your continued support so that valuable instructional time is not spent examining student attire to determine appropriateness.

Creek View Elementary is a "Croc-Free" and "Flip-Flop Free" School Zone.

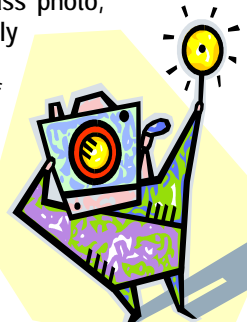


## Spring Pictures
