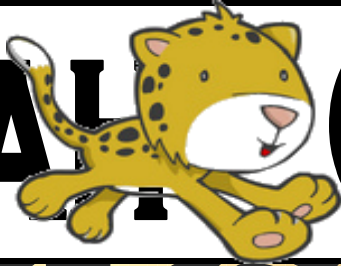

Dear Creek View Elementary School Families,

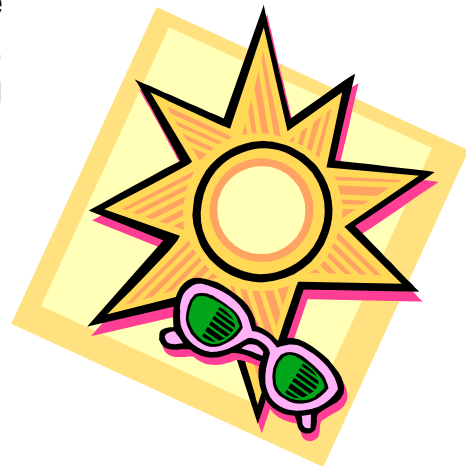

# Creek View Nature Trail



The campus at Creek view has a wonderful new nature trail that provides a place for classes to explore a wooded area with plant life native to Georgia. It is also being used for brief hikes. This nature trail was planned, developed, and built under the leadership of Reese Cherry, a Boy Scout from Troop 10 in the Milton District. Reese was working on achieving Eagle Scout rank.

Projects such as this require at least ninety hours of planning, pages of paper work, and then the actual work and installation. Leadership is also required as other scouts assist in various ways. Reese earned some of the funding for the project, and other funding came from a Lowe's Toolbox Grant. Another scout is presently writing a proposal for an outdoor classroom at the end of the present trail.
